

A Word about Safety in KidzPoint:

We want KidzPoint to be a safe place for children. We understand that safety and security are among a child's highest needs. In KidzPoint, we are committed to providing a place where parents and children alike know that we have their best interests as our top priority at all times. That's why safety is a must.

We are committed to:

- Having room environments with age-appropriate equipment
- Conducting background checks and interviews with all volunteers
- Ensuring that all volunteers wear nametags at all times while serving
- Having name tags on all children
- The enforcement of check-in procedure

Our Check-In Procedure:

Upon arrival at the KidzPoint Check-In Station, each child and parent will receive a wristband. The wristbands will match in color and will display the family ID number. In order for a parent to gain access to KidzPoint, he/she must be wearing a wristband. In order for a parent to pick-up his/her child after the service, the family ID number on the parent's wristband must match the ID number on the child's wristband.

Discovery Bay children and parents wear blue wristbands.

Paradise Island children and parents wear gold wristbands

Children who have food allergies or medical conditions wear red wristbands. Their parents also wear red wristbands. This red wristband immediately alerts our volunteer team to consult this child's records to obtain pertinent information.

Children have to face scary situations too often in their lives. We want our kids to be able to know without hesitation that they are safe in KidzPoint and safe in their church.
